### ***How to Host a “bowl painting party” for Soup's On!***

to benefit the food and pantry programs of Catholic Charities West Michigan (CCWM).

These programs include Christian Community Center in Muskegon Heights,  
God's Kitchen in Grand Rapids, and Loaves & Fishes Food Pantry in Muskegon.

Is as easy as...

1. Choosing a “**paint date**”. \*\*
2. Selecting a location (God's Kitchen, Loaves & Fishes Food Pantry or a location of your choice – home, business, church, community center, etc.).  
**We will bring the bowls, paints, and supplies to you!**
3. Contacting me (Julie Tamblin) to **confirm the painting date you've chosen is available** and discuss additional details (approximate number of people painting, number of bowls needed, pick-up and drop-off dates, etc.)

#### **Additional Important Information:**

Each year we need 1500 bowls painted for the *Soup's On!* Events. The bowls are painted by generous volunteers from the community like you, with the majority of the bowls used as guest thank-you's. Each guest attending **Soup's On!** will be able to choose a bowl to take home, while some of the other bowls are sold or auctioned to raise additional funds for God's Kitchen, Christian Community Center and Loaves & Fishes Food Pantry.

No painting experience required, only a willingness to help. This is how it works. You purchase the bowl(s), paint and donate it back to God's Kitchen or the Christian Community Center and Loaves & Fishes Food Pantry to be used at **Soup's On!** For your convenience, we will deliver the bowl(s) and necessary supplies and pick up them back up from you. **The cost per bowl is \$8 (cash or check payable to Catholic Charities West Michigan )** and covers the cost of the bowl, supplies, and the final glazing and firing; which we do in kilns at God's Kitchen once we've picked the bowls back up from you.

\*After the bowls have gone through the final glazing/firing process they are food safe\*
